ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

Since its acquisition by Honduras Outreach, Inc., thousands of visitors from the United States have enjoyed remarkably rewarding visits to Rancho el Paraiso. Because the ranch is a working farm in a relatively inaccessible area of central Honduras, it is very important that visitors be in good health and understand in advance the conditions at the ranch and the travel required to get there. In exchange for the opportunity to visit the ranch, visitors and parents of minor youths who visit are asked by Honduras Outreach to release it from and indemnify it against certain types of claims.

*Ranch Location and Conditions; Medical Considerations*

Rancho el Paraiso is located in rural, central Honduras many miles from the nearest telephone. The visit to the ranch will involve travel on domestic and international air carriers, as well as buses and possibly other land transportation. Only some of the roads are paved, and they are not well patrolled by public safety officers. As is true in most of the world, crimes against property and people occur with some frequency in the areas of Honduras that will be visited, and there is some risk of theft, kidnapping, terrorism and other violent crimes. Routine communications with the ranch are not possible, and emergency communications are unreliable. Medical services, particularly emergency services, consistent with United States' standards are *not* available, and the nearest hospital is located several hour's drive from the ranch.

The Ranch is operated in an effort to assure the health and safety of both visitors and the Hondurans who live and work there. However, it is a working farm with the inherently dangerous conditions requiring care on the part of visitors associated with any farm, including the presence of farm equipment and horses, cattle and other large animals. Visitors to Honduras and the ranch must share responsibility for protecting their own health and safety by taking appropriate precautions before and during their trip, observing common sense and the safety rules of the ranch and following the advice of Honduras Outreach staff members throughout their visit to Honduras.

You should consult with your personal physician before your trip to Honduras and obtain all appropriate vaccinations and protective medicines. You should have a physical if you have not recently had one, and you must supply Honduras Outreach with a physician's statement indicating that your doctor is not aware of any health condition or other reason you should not participant in the trip planned to Rancho el Paraiso.

*Release by Each Visitor to Ranch el Paraiso*

**Each person desiring to visit the ranch must read carefully and MUST sign and notarize the following release.**

RELEASE

In consideration of the opportunity afforded me by Honduras Outreach, Inc. to visit Rancho el Paraiso, and in recognition of the possible hazards to which I may voluntarily subject myself on the ranch and in traveling outside the United States of America to visit a substantially less developed region of the world, I acknowledge that I have read and understand the information set forth above, and I hereby knowingly, freely and voluntarily waive any right, claim or cause of action, of any kind whatsoever, arising as a result of my visit to Rancho el Paraiso there, including travel relating to the visit, from which any liability may or could accrue to Honduras Outreach, Inc., its officers, directors or employees (collectively, the "Releasees") and I hereby release the Releasees from any such claim or causes of action I may in the future have against any of them arising out of such activities.
